## City of Sydney releases Master Plan for Redfern Park redevelopment

As we all prepare to take to the field of Redfern Oval for the last time, the City of Sydney has finally released its much anticipated Master Plan for the redeveloped Redfern Park. The new park will include a \$19 million training/playing facility which can be used by sporting and cultural groups.

The South Sydney Rabbitohs will have a state-of-the-art gym, private change room, video playback suite and medical facility. Lighting of the facility will be to Australian Standards for training. As well as being the Rabbitohs training centre, the new facility will become the home ground for the Redfern All Blacks and will host Souths Juniors gala days and finals series as it currently does.

The new Grandstand will run the full length of the playing field but will not be as deep as the current Reg Cope Grandstand. It will seat 1500 people on a permanent basis but with the grassed terraces around the field the ground capacity is expected to be 5000 with the potential for 3000 temporary seats to be used for larger events.

## ARLRA Law Quiz – Kicks/Free Kicks

What would your decision be after each of the following circumstance?

1. Red is awarded a penalty and elects to kick for touch. The ball crosses the touch in-goal line.  
a) 20 metre optional restart by blue      b) 20 metre dropout by blue;
2. Red is awarded a penalty and elects to kick for goal. The attempt is unsuccessful and the ball is caught on the full by Blue in the Blue in-goal.  
a) Play on      b) 20 metre dropout by blue;
3. Red is awarded a penalty 3 metres out from the Blue goal line. Red decides to take a tap but takes the ball back to the Blue 20 metre line. Where must the Blue defence stay?

4. Blue directly punt kicks a free kick and the ball is caught by Red on the full in the Red in-goal.

### Redfern Park Master Plan

A significant part of the redevelopment will be the removal of the Reg Cope Grandstand along with all exterior walls and earth-mounds so as to give the visual impression that the park continues from Redfern Street to Phillip Street, uninterrupted.

The new pitch will be sunken below street level allowing grass covered terraced seating to be installed around its perimeter.

The referees change room will be located closest to the players tunnel and will be 35m<sup>2</sup> and will meet FIFA standards. Council has not approved enclosed media broadcast boxes but other options are being explored. The Appointments Board may be able to use the fully glass-enclosed Multi-purpose Meeting Room which overlooks the pitch. This room can be seen to the right of the picture below.

The finals were not expected to be played at Redfern Oval this year, as demolition of the ground was expected to start before now. However a Red & Green Ban by the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union has prevented any work commencing pending the release of the Master Plan. It is expected that all objections to the redevelopment have been overcome, and work should commence shortly. Once started, it is anticipated that the new ground should be ready in 18 months time.
